THE CUSTOMS PRIMAGE (YARNS) EXEMPTION ORDER 1960

Pursuant to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage (Yarns) Exemption Order 1960.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 22nd day of July 1960.
- 2. The classes of goods set out in the First Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931.
- 3. (1) The Customs Primage Order 1937, No. 1,* is hereby consequentially amended by omitting from the Schedule the words "and yarn".
- (2) The Customs Primage Exemption Order 1949† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to cotton yarn.
- **4.** The Orders in Council specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby consequentially revoked.

Goods Exempted from Primage Duty
