HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage Exemption Order (No. 3) 1951.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 6th day of July, 1951.

2. The class of goods included in the Tariff item set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1931.
