HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage Exemption Order (No. 6) 1951.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 2nd day of November 1951.

2. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931.

SCHEDULE

EXEMPTIONS FROM PRIMAGE DUTY

Tariff Item No.	Tariff Item
102	(2) <i>Asphalt</i> and <i>bitumen</i> .
205	<i>Rubber</i> , manufactures of, viz. :— (1) Articles composed wholly or principally of rubber, viz. :— (a) Water beds and cushions, ice bags and caps, air beds, air cushions, urinals.
307	Ball bearings, and roller bearings, not being ball or roller bearing plummer or hanger blocks; steel balls, and rollers, suitable for ball or roller bearings.
388	Wheels, and tires, for locomotives or railway or tramway vehicles, whether affixed to axles or separate.
