ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 8th day of May 1957

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage (Electric Lamps) Exemption Order 1957.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 10th day of May 1957.

2. The class of goods set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931.
