



**THE CUSTOMS PORTS OF ENTRY NOTICE 1980,  
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

PURSUANT to section 26 of the Customs Act 1966, the Comptroller of Customs, in accordance with the power delegated to the Comptroller by the Minister of Customs under section 9 of that Act, hereby gives the following notice.

**NOTICE**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Ports of Entry Notice 1980, Amendment No. 4 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Ports of Entry Notice 1980\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1989.

**2. Ports of entry**—(1) It is hereby declared that Hamilton, Rotorua, and Palmerston shall cease to be ports of entry for purposes of the Customs Acts.

(2) The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby consequentially amended by revoking the items relating to Hamilton, Rotorua, and Palmerston.
