

THE CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS (ENFORCEMENT OF FINES) FEE REGULATIONS 1988

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Crimes Act 1961 and to section 100A of the Judicature Act 1908 (as substituted by section 11 (1) of the Judicature Amendment Act (No. 2) 1985), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Criminal Proceedings (Enforcement of Fines) Fee Regulations 1988.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 11th day of April 1988.
- 2. Court fee in respect of warrant to collect fine or other sum of money ordered to be paid.—The Court fee payable in respect of every warrant to collect a fine or other sum of money issued under section 19c of the Crimes Act 1961 (which warrant is required by rule 4 (1) of the Criminal Proceedings (Enforcement of Fines) Rules 1967* to be in form 3 in the Schedule to those rules) shall be \$55.

- **3. Goods and services tax included**—The fee prescribed in regulation 2 of these regulations is inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.
- **4. Revocations**—(1) The Criminal Proceedings (Enforcement of Fines) Fee Regulations 1987* are hereby revoked.
- (2) The Fees Regulations 1987† are hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to the Criminal Proceedings (Enforcement of Fines) Fee Regulations 1987.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 11 April 1988, increase from \$50 to \$55 the Court fee payable in respect of every warrant to collect a fine or other sum of money issued under section 19c of the Crimes Act 1961.

The fee is inclusive of goods and services tax.
