Pursuant to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage (Dry Paints and Colours) Exemption Order 1958.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 11th day of July 1958.
- 2. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931.
- 3. The Customs Primage (Paints and Related Products) Exemption Order 1957* is hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule so much thereof as relates to Tariff item 397 (1) (d), (g).
