THE COAL-MINES REGULATIONS, 1927, AMENDMENT NO. 2.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Coal-mines Act, 1925.

Date on which the regulations were made: 15th day of February, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 4th day of March, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Coal-mines Regulations, 1927, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations under the Coal-mines Act, 1925, made on the 15th day of June, 1927* (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification thereof in the Gazette.
- ${\bf 4.}$ Clause 56 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted :—
- "56. (1) The office of the Warden's Court shall be open to the public daily except on Sundays, Saturdays, and holidays.
- "(2) The hours during which the office shall be so open shall be from 9.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.
- "(3) Nevertheless when the Clerk has to attend more offices than one he shall keep his office open on such days and hours as the Warden from time to time appoints.
- "(4) A notice of the office days and hours shall be kept posted in some conspicuous place inside and outside the office."
