**THE COAL-MINES REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 23rd day of August, 1939.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Coal-mines Act, 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Coal-mines Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations under the Coal-mines Act, 1925, made on the 19th day of July, 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification thereof in the *Gazette*.
4. Regulation 266 of the principal regulations is amended as follows :—
 - (a) By deleting from paragraph (i) of clause 12 (a) (b) the words “ or an approved carbon-monoxide detector ”.
 - (b) By adding to paragraph (ii) of clause 12 (a) (b) the words “ or an approved carbon-monoxide detector ” :
