THE COAL-MINES REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 23rd day of August, 1939.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Coal-mines Act, 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Coal-mines Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations under the Coal-mines Act, 1925, made on the 19th day of July, 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- **3.** These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification thereof in the *Gazette*.
- **4.** Regulation 266 of the principal regulations is amended as follows:—
 - (a) By deleting from paragraph (i) of clause 12 (a) (b) the words "or an approved carbon-monoxide detector".
 - (b) By adding to paragraph (ii) of clause 12 (a) (b) the words "or an approved carbon-monoxide detector":
