



**THE CORONERS REGULATIONS 1952, AMENDMENT NO. 14**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 20th day of October 1986

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 33 of the Coroners Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Coroners Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 14, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Coroners Regulations 1952\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Coroners' fees**—(1) Regulation 13 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraphs (a) to (c) (as substituted by

regulation 2 (1) of the Coroners Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 12), and substituting the following paragraphs:

“(a) For every inquest held by him, a fee of \$41:

“(b) Where 2 or more persons are killed on 1 occasion and the circumstances of their deaths are investigated by him at a single inquest or at several inquests held on the same day or on consecutive working days, in respect of the first person a fee of \$41, and in respect of every other such person a fee of \$15:

“(c) For every case where he decides under section 6 of the Act not to hold or to discontinue an inquest, a fee of \$20.”

(2) Regulation 13 (3) of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 (2) of the Coroners Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 12) is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$4.00”, and substituting the expression “\$5”.

**3. Revocation**—The Coroners Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 12 are hereby consequentially revoked.
