PURSUANT to the Chiropractors Act 1960, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Chiropractors Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chiropractors Regulations 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Fee for annual practising certificate—Regulation 5 (3) of the principal regulations, as amended by section 7 of the Decimal Currency Act 1964, is hereby amended by omitting the expression "shall be \$42", and substituting the expression "in respect of the year beginning on the 1st day of April 1977 or on that day in any subsequent year shall be \$60".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fee for a chiropractor's annual practising certificate to \$60. The present fee is \$42.
