



**THE CHIROPODISTS REGULATIONS 1967,
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

PURSUANT to the Medical and Dental Auxiliaries Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Chiroprudists Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chiroprudists Regulations 1967* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1977.

2. Fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 8, and substituting the following regulation:

“8. (1) The fee for registration as a chiroprudist shall be \$20.

“(2) The fee for a certificate of registration as a chiroprudist shall be \$3.

“(3) The fee for a provisional certificate entitling a person to perform chiroprudity shall be \$2.

“(4) The fee for an annual licence issued to a registered chiroprudist shall be \$8.

“(5) The fee for any alteration in or addition to an entry in the register, other than a change of address or correction of an error for which the person registered is not responsible, shall be \$5.

“(6) The fee for restoration of a name to the register under section 21 of the Act shall be \$5.

“(7) The fee for inspection of the register shall be \$5.

“(8) The fee for examination under regulation 4 (1) (g) of these regulations shall be \$25.”

(2) Regulation 3 of the Chiropodists Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 2 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Chiropodists Regulations 1967.

Regulation 1 relates to the Title and commencement. The regulations come into force on 1 March 1977.

Regulation 2 substitutes a new (and, in general, increased) scale of fees in respect of the various matters specified in the regulation.
