THE QUEEN'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 34 of the Decimal Currency Act 1964 and the Royal Powers Act 1953, Her Majesty the Queen, acting by and with the advice and consent of Her Executive Council, is pleased to make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Coinage Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Coinage Regulations 1967* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. New Zealand Day Commemorative Dollar—(1) Notwithstanding regulation 2 (a) of the principal regulations, the design for the one-dollar coin to be known as the New Zealand Day Commemorative Dollar, to be made and issued pursuant to section 10 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964, shall be as follows:

(a) For the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty the Queen in profile wearing a diamond tiara of festoons, scrolls, and collet-spikes, with the inscription "Elizabeth II New Zealand" and the date "1974":

(b) For the reverse impression a kotuku (white heron) in flight against the rising sun with the words "New Zealand Day 6 Feb." above the kotuku, and the words "One Dollar" below the rising sun. There shall be a wave pattern around the periphery of the coin.

(2) Except as aforesaid, all the provisions of the principal regulations relating to the one-dollar coin shall apply to the coin referred to in subclause (1) of this regulation.
