ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 25, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 21st day of November 1986.

2. Fees for officers' time outside working hours—(1) Regulation 14 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 (1) of the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 11 and regulation 3 (1) of the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 17) is hereby further amended—

- (a) By omitting from subclause (1)(a) the expression "\$15.50", and substituting the expression "\$50":
- (b) By omitting from subclause (1)(b) the expression "\$13.75", and substituting the expression "\$45":
- (c) By omitting from subclause (2) the expression "\$46.50", and substituting the expression "\$150".

(2) The Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 17 are hereby consequently amended by revoking regulation 3.

These regulations, which come into force on 21 November 1986, increase the rates of fees for officers' time outside working hours.
