ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 19th day of December 1986

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 232 and 237 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 26 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Licence fee—(1) Regulation 135 (1) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 6 of the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 11 and amended by regulation 9 of the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 15) is hereby further amended—

(a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “\$70”, and substituting the expression “\$165”;

(b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the expression “\$12”, and substituting the expression “\$33”.

(2) Regulation 135 (2) of the principal regulations (as so substituted) is hereby amended by omitting the words “15th day of January”, and substituting the words “1st day of February”.

(3) The Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 15 are hereby consequentially amended by revoking regulation 9.

3. Customs carriers—(1) Regulation 136 (2) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 7 of the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 11 and amended by regulation 10 of the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 15) is hereby further amended:

(a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “\$70”, and substituting the expression “\$165”;

(b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the expression “\$12”, and substituting the expression “\$33”.

(2) Regulation 136 (3) of the principal regulations (as so substituted) is hereby amended by omitting the words “15th day of January”, and substituting the words “1st day of February”.

(3) The Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 15 are hereby consequentially amended by revoking regulation 10.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Customs Regulations 1968.

Regulations 2 and 3 increase the licence fees for Customs agents and Customs carriers, and extends the dates for the payment of the annual fees from 15 January to 1 February.
