THE RIGHT HON. J. B. BOLGER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to section 306 of the Customs Act 1966, Her Excellency the
Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the
Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 37, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 23rd day of February 1995.
- 2. Grouping of countries—Regulation 69 (1) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 8 (1) of the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 13) is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (d), and substituting the following paragraph:

 "(d) Group IV: The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern

Ireland, the Isle of Man, and the Channel Islands:".

- 3. United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man, and the Channel Islands (Group IV)—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 72A (as substituted by regulation 8 (1) of the Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 13), and substituting the following regulation:
- "72A. United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man, and the Channel Islands (Group IV)—The following shall be the classes of goods entitled to be entered under the Tariff at the rates and exemptions provided for the countries included in Group IV, namely:
 - "(a) Goods wholly the produce of the countries included in Group IV: "(b) Goods wholly manufactured in the countries included in Group IV

from unmanufactured raw materials:

- "(c) Goods partly manufactured in the countries included in Group IV
 - subject to the following conditions: "(i) That the process last performed in the manufacture of the goods was performed in a country included in Group IV; and

"(ii) That in respect of the goods, the expenditure—

"(A) In material that is the origin of one or more countries

included in Group IV; or

"(B) In other items of factory or works cost (as defined in regulation 73 hereof) incurred in one or more countries included in Group IV; or

"(C) Partly in such material and partly in such other items as

aforesaid,-

is not less than half of the factory or works cost of the goods in their finished state.'

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 28 February 1995, make amendments to the Customs Regulations 1968 that are consequential on the passage of the Tariff Amendment Act 1994. Under that Act, the preferential rate of duty formerly afforded under the Tariff to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man, the Channel Islands, and the Republic of Ireland ceases to be afforded to the Republic of Ireland. These regulations remove from the principal regulations references to the Republic of Ireland that are no longer appropriate.
