ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of June 1982

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 28 of the Citizenship Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Citizenship Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Citizenship Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 2nd day of July 1982.

2. New scale of fees substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
