

# THE CITIZENSHIP REGULATIONS 1978, AMENDMENT NO. 1

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of June 1982

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 28 of the Citizenship Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Citizenship Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Citizenship Regulations 1978\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 2nd day of July 1982.
- 2. New scale of fees substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
