ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 28 of the Citizenship Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Citizenship Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Citizenship Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1986.
- 2. New scale of fees substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Citizenship Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **3. Revocation**—The Citizenship Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1 are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 August 1986, increase fees payable for various matters under the Citizenship Act 1977. In addition they require a fee of \$15 to be paid on an application for a grant of citizenship pursuant to section 7 of the Citizenship (Western Samoa) Act 1982.
