



THE CHIROPRACTORS REGULATIONS 1994

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 28th day of February 1994

Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 44 (a) of the Chiropractors Act 1982, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister of Health given after consultation with the Chiropractic Board, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Chiropractors Regulations 1994.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1994.

2. Interpretation—In these regulations “the Act” means the Chiropractors Act 1982.

3. Fees—(1) The fee payable in respect of an application for registration under section 16 of the Act shall be \$550.00.

(2) The fee for the issue of a certificate of registration under section 19 of the Act shall be \$30.00.

(3) The fee for the issue of a certificate of temporary registration under section 23 of the Act shall be \$300.00.

(4) The fee for the issue of an annual practising certificate under section 25 of the Act shall be \$750.00.

(5) The fee for the issue of a copy of any certificate shall be \$30.00.

(6) The fee for supplying to a chiropractor any document for the purpose of seeking registration overseas shall be \$50.00.

4. Fees inclusive of goods and services tax—The fees fixed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

5. Revocation—The Chiropractors Regulations 1993* are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1994, prescribe a new and increased scale of fees payable under the Chiropractors Act 1982.

The fees prescribed are inclusive of goods and services tax.
