**THE CAMPING-GROUND REGULATIONS EXTENSION
NOTICE 1947**

Department of Health,
Wellington, 30th June, 1947.

PURSUANT to the Health Act, 1920, and pursuant to the Camping-ground Regulations 1936,* I, Mabel Bowden Howard, Minister of Health, do hereby give notice as follows.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Camping-ground Regulations Extension Notice 1947.

2. This notice shall take effect on the 1st day of July, 1947.

3. The Camping-ground Regulations 1936 are hereby applied to the Akaroa Borough, the Kaitaia Borough, the Clifton County, and the Heathcote County.

4. The Camping-ground Regulations Extension Consolidation Notice 1946† is amended as follows:—

(a) Part I of the Second Schedule thereto is amended by inserting therein, next following the references to the City of Auckland and the Borough of Invercargill respectively, the following additional items:—

“ Akaroa 1st July, 1947.

“ Kaitaia—

“ In part, former Town District of

Kaitaia 1st April, 1945.

“ In part, formerly part of County

of Monganui 1st July, 1947.”

(b) Part II of the Second Schedule thereto is amended by deleting therefrom the following item:—

“ Kaitaia.. .. . 1st April, 1945.”

(c) Part III of the Second Schedule thereto is amended by inserting therein, next following the references to the County of Castlepoint and County of Hawke's Bay respectively, the following additional items:—

“ Clifton 1st July, 1947.

“ Heathcote 1st July, 1947.”
