THE CHEESE-MANUFACTURE RESTRICTION ORDER 1941.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in me by the Primary Industries Emergency Regulations 1939, I, James Gillispie Barclay, Minister of Agriculture, hereby make the following Order.

Ô R D E R.

1. This Order may be cited as the Cheese-manufacture Restriction Order 1941.

2. This Order shall come into force on the second day after notification hereof in the *Gazette*.

3. On and after the date of the coming into force of this Order no person, being the occupier of premises registered as a cheese-factory pursuant to the Dairy-produce Regulations 1938, shall incorporate or cause or permit to be incorporated in any milk intended for the manufacture of cheese or in any cheese at any stage of its manufacture any colouring ingredient or constituent which is designed or intended to produce, or has the effect of producing, coloured cheese.
