



THE CLOTHING RATIONING ORDER 1943

PURSUANT to Regulation 8 of the Rationing Emergency Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the regulations) the Minister of Supply and Munitions doth hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Clothing Rationing Order 1943, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Clothing Rationing Order 1942† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
2. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1943.
3. The retailers of the rationed goods referred to in the principal Order shall be licensed under the regulations.
