Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Cadastral Survey (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2007.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 September 2007.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Cadastral Survey (Fees) Regulations 2003.

The Schedule is amended by revoking Part 1 and substituting the Part 1 set out in the Schedule of these regulations.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 September 2007, replace Part 1 of the Schedule of the Cadastral Survey (Fees) Regulations 2003, which sets fees for determining whether cadastral survey datasets comply with standards set under section 49 of Cadastral Survey Act 2002.
