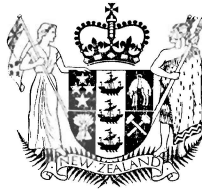

**THE CUSTOMS SURTAX (ELECTRIC BATTERIES OTHER
THAN STORAGE BATTERIES) EXEMPTION
ORDER 1957**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 20th day of March 1957

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Surtax (Electric Batteries other than Storage Batteries) Exemption Order 1957.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 22nd day of March 1957.

2. (1) The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930.

(2) The Customs Surtax (Electric Batteries) Exemption Order 1956* is hereby revoked.
