**THE CUSTOMS SURTAX (PISTONS, CYLINDER SLEEVES,
AND PISTON RINGS) EXEMPTION ORDER 1957**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 1st day of May 1957

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Surtax (Pistons, Cylinder Sleeves, and Piston Rings) Exemption Order 1957.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 3rd day of May 1957.

2. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930.

3. The Customs Surtax Exemption Order (No. 4) 1955* is hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule so much thereof as relates to Tariff item 353 (11).

SCHEDULE

GOODS EXEMPTED FROM SURTAX

Tariff Item No.	Classes of Goods
353	Machinery, machines, engines, and <i>other appliances</i> , n.e.i., viz: (11) <i>Pistons, cylinder sleeves, and piston rings</i> , viz: (a) For use in cylinders having a <i>bore</i> not exceeding 4 inches except such <i>pistons, cylinder sleeves, and piston rings</i> as may be determined by the Minister. (b) Other kinds.
