ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 3rd day of June 1953  
Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1932,  
His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice  
and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following  
order.

**ORDER**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Surtax Exemption  
Order 1953.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 5th day of June 1953.

2. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto (being the  
produce or manufacture of any part of the British dominions not  
already exempted by subsection (1) of the said section 6) are hereby  
exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts  
Amendment Act 1930.

**SCHEDULE**

**GOODS EXEMPTED FROM SURTAX WHEN PRODUCED OR MANUFACTURED IN  
BRITISH DOMINIONS**

Tariff Item No.	Tariff Item.
356	(3) Builders' and cabinetmakers' hardware, viz.:— (a) Hinges (not being <i>gate hinges</i> ) suited for doors, box-lids, or <i>similar</i> articles, viz.:— (i) Butt hinges of steel, including back-flaps, whether black, bright, polished, galvanized, plated, or otherwise coated with metal or other material.
