HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Surtax (Footwear) Exemption Order 1957.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 7th day of June 1957.

2. (1) The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930.

(2) The Customs Surtax Exemption Order (No. 5) 1955^* is hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule so much thereof as relates to Tariff items 196 (1) and 196 (2).

SCHEDULE Goods Exempted from Surtax

196	 Footwear, n.e.i., viz.: (1) Children's sizes 0 to 8½ inclusive. (2) Children's exceeding size 8½ but not exceeding size 13.
