## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 21st day of November 1960

Pursuant to section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Surtax (Yarns) Exemption Order 1960.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the

22nd day of July 1960.

- 2. The classes of goods set out in the First Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930.
- 3. The Orders in Council specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby consequentially revoked.
