PURSUANT to section 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1932, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Surtax Exemption Order (No. 2) 1953.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 18th day of December 1953.

2. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930.

SCHEDULE**GOODS EXEMPTED FROM SURTAX**

16	Cocoa and chocolate, viz.: (1) (a) <i>Cocoa</i> . (2) Chocolate; also cocoa or chocolate mixed with milk or with any other food substance.
32	(1) <i>Confectionery</i> n.e.i., including medicated confectionery, liquorice n.e.i., and sugared or crystallized fruits. (2) Sugared or crystallized vegetable products n.e.i.; fruits and other vegetable products processed in syrup but not imported in liquid; ginger preserved in syrup.
351	Ex (4) Vacuum cleaners, viz.: (a) Electric. (b) Other.
