Pursuant to section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Surtax (Stock Foods) Exemption Order 1956.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 24th day of August 1956.
- 2. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930.

GOODS EXEMPTED FROM SURTAX

2	Animals, food for, of all kinds, n.e.i., including horse and cattle spices and condiments, proprietary or otherwise; mixed bird
3	seed. Chaff.
