**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 22nd day of August 1956

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Surtax (Stock Foods) Exemption Order 1956.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 24th day of August 1956.

2. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930.

**GOODS EXEMPTED FROM SURTAX**

2	Animals, food for, of all kinds, n.e.i., including horse and cattle spices and condiments, proprietary or otherwise; mixed bird seed.
3	Chaff.
