PURSUANT to the Companies Special Investigations Act 1958, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Companies Special Investigations Order 1959, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Companies Special Investigations Order 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. The principal order is hereby amended by adding the following clause:

“3. Arthur Walter Christmas of Auckland, Public Accountant, is hereby appointed as receiver and manager in respect of the said companies.”
