**THE COMPANIES SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS ORDER 1972,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

At the Government House at Wellington this 20th day of November 1972

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Companies Special Investigations Act 1958, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister of Justice given on the recommendation of a committee appointed under section 472 of the Companies Act 1955, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Companies Special Investigations Order 1972, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Companies Special Investigations Order 1972* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Act to apply to certain companies—The Schedule to the principal order (as amended by the Companies Special Investigations Order 1972, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by adding to the part thereof relating to companies incorporated in New Zealand the names of the following companies:

“Argo Finance Limited.

“L. J. Hansen Limited.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order applies the Companies Special Investigations Act 1958 to the companies named in the order, and the receiver and manager appointed under clause 3 of the principal order in respect of the companies to which the principal order applies will be the receiver and manager of these additional companies also.
