PURSUANT to the Companies Special Investigations Act 1958, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Companies Special Investigations Order 1972, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Companies Special Investigations Order 1972* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Act to cease to apply to JBL Minerals (NZ) Limited—The Schedule to the principal order, as amended by clause 2 of the Companies Special Investigations Order 1972, Amendment No. 1, is hereby further amended by omitting the expression “JBL Minerals (NZ) Limited”.
