PURSUANT to the Companies Special Investigations Act 1958, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and, in relation to clause 2 hereof, on the advice of the Minister of Justice given on the recommendation of a committee appointed under section 472 of the Companies Act 1955, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement-(1) This order may be cited as the Companies Special Investigations Order (No. 3) 1976.

(2) This order shall come into force at 4 p.m. on the 10th day of May 1976.

2. Act to apply to certain companies-It is hereby declared that the Companies Special Investigations Act 1958 shall apply to the companies specified in the Schedule to this order.

3. Receiver and manager-Frederick Nelson Watson of Auckland, Chartered Accountant, is hereby appointed receiver and manager in respect of each company to which this order applies.
