Pursuant to section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Customs Surtax (Dairying Machinery) Exemption Order 1958.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 3rd day of October 1958.
- 2. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930.

SCHEDULE

GOODS EXEMPTED FROM SURTAX

Tariff Item No.	Classes of Goods
334	Dairying machinery, and appliances, viz: (1) Churns, power driven, including butter-workers; butter-packers, butter-pounders, and cheese-presses. (2) (a) Milking machine parts wholly of rubber.
