EXEMPTION ORDER 1958**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 1st day of October 1958

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Customs Surtax (Dairying Machinery) Exemption Order 1958.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 3rd day of October 1958.

2. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930.

SCHEDULE

GOODS EXEMPTED FROM SURTAX

Tariff Item No.	Classes of Goods
334	Dairying machinery, and appliances, viz: (1) <i>Churns</i> , power driven, including butter-workers; butter-packers, butter-pounders, and cheese-presses. (2) (a) Milking machine parts <i>wholly of rubber</i> .
