## THE CUSTOMS SURTAX ORDER 1952

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1930,  
His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice  
and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Surtax Order 1952.  
(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the  
20th day of November 1951.

2. The class of goods set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby  
exempted from the surtax imposed by section 5 of the Customs Acts  
Amendment Act 1930.

### SCHEDULE

#### EXEMPTION FROM SURTAX

Item No.	Class of Goods.
Ex 192 .....	Yarns of cotton, on declaration by a manufacturer that they will be used by him only in the manufacture of tubular woven or knitted cotton cloth specially suited for use as meat wraps.
