PURSUANT to section 295 of the Customs Act, 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Methylated Spirit) Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 1.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Customs (Methylated Spirit) Regulations 1936* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1947.
4. Regulation 23 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words "a charge of 2s. 6d. per hour or any portion of an hour", and substituting the words "a charge of 4s. per hour or portion of an hour".
