THE CHRISTCHURCH SECONDARY SCHOOLS REGULATIONS 1966, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to section 57 of the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Christchurch Secondary Schools Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch Secondary Schools Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1970.
- 2. Board of Governors of Papanui High School—Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "Linwood High School" in each case where they occur in subclause (1), the words "the Papanui High School".
- 3. Revocations—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulations 6, 11, and 12, and subclause (2) of regulation 10.
- 4. Members of former Board to remain in office—Notwithstanding the revocation of regulation 6 of the principal regulations, the members of the Board of Governors of the Papanui High School constituted under that regulation who were in office immediately before the commencement of these regulations shall continue to hold office until the 31st day of March 1970, and shall then go out of office.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

This amendment provides for the Papanui High School Board to have the same constitution as the other Boards of secondary schools that are under the Christ-church Secondary School Council.
