

THE CUSTOMS TARIFF (PROFESSIONAL AND DISPLAY EQUIPMENT) AMENDMENT ORDER 1977

PURSUANT to section 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Professional and Display Equipment) Amendment Order 1977.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 17th day of August 1977.
- 2. Tariff amended—Part II (Concessions) of the Customs Tariff is hereby amended by the addition of the reference numbers 36.0 and 37.0 and the associated descriptions and exemptions from duty as specified in the Schedule hereto.
