THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER (NO. 11) 1969

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of September  
1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates and exemptions specified in the Customs Tariff (as set out in the Second Schedule to the Customs Act 1966 and heretofore modified) are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner generally to the public interest and particularly to certain industries carried on in New Zealand, and that it is necessary for the protection of those industries that the duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto should be imposed, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 11) 1969.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Portions of Tariff suspended**—The portions of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended.

**3. Duties imposed and exemptions created**—The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

**4. Revocation**—The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 9) 1968\* is hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order makes provision for increases in the rates of Customs duty (by means of determination by the Minister of Customs) on certain circular saw blades exceeding 12 in. in diameter.
