## THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER (NO. 11) 1973

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 2nd day of April 1973

Present:

THE HON. M. RATA PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates and exemptions specified in the Customs Tariff, are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner in respect of industries carried on in New Zealand, and that it is necessary for the protection of those industries that the duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto should be imposed, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 11) 1973.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Portion of Tariff suspended**—The portion of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto is hereby suspended.

**3. Duties imposed and exemptions created**—The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

**4. Consequential revocations**—The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 2) 1972\* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Tariff items 69.11.001, 69.11.002, 69.11.009, 69.12.001, 69.12.002, and 69.12.009.
