**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 125 of the Customs Act 1966 and section 5 of the Customs Amendment Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 13) 1971.

(2) This order shall come into force on 1 January 1972.

**2. Tariff amended**—The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 11) 1971\* is hereby amended—

(a) By revoking the First Schedule, and substituting the First Schedule set out in the First Schedule to this order:

(b) By revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Second Schedule of this order.
