## THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER (NO. 13) 1972

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 31st day of July 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being exemptions specified in the Customs Tariff, are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner in respect of industries carried on in New Zealand, and that it is necessary for the protection of those industries that the duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto should be imposed, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 13) 1972.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Portion of Tariff suspended**—The portion of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto is hereby suspended.

**3. Duties imposed and exemptions created**—The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemption from duty in that Schedule is hereby created.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order provides for increases in the rates of Customs duty on solder falling in headings 78.01, 78.02, 80.01, and 80.02 of the Customs Tariff.

The increases imposed by this order result from a recommendation made by the Tariff and Development Board.
