ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of December 1973

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 125 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of opinion that the exercise of the power conferred by the said section 125 is advisable in furtherance of the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 17) 1973.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1974.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the rates of duty and exemptions from duty set out in the Schedule hereto, being rates of duty and exemptions from duty shown in the column headed Most Favoured Nation opposite the Tariff items referred to in that Schedule.

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.
This order has the effect of withdrawing certain preferential rates of duty accorded to South Africa in terms of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade; it aligns duties on goods produced or manufactured in South Africa with those applicable to goods from other Most Favoured Nation countries.
