THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER, 1937, NO. 1.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Date of enactment: 9th day of April, 1937.

Date of notification in Gazette: 15th day of April, 1937.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authority conferred on him by section 12 of the Customs Amendment Act, 1921, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of opinion that the existing duties are likely to operate in an injurious manner generally to the public interest, doth hereby order as follows :--

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment

Order, 1937, No. 1. 2. The existing tariff (being the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1934) is suspended in so far as it relates to the goods set out in the First Schedule hereto.

3. The duties set forth in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemption from duty set out therein is hereby created.

4. Nothing in this Order shall be deemed to affect the provisions of section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1930, or section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1931, in respect of the imposition on any goods affected by this Order of surtax or primage duty, as the case may be.

5. So far as it has the effect of exempting any goods from Customs duty, or of reducing the rate or amount of Customs duty payable in respect of any goods, this Order shall be retrospective to and including the 1st day of March, 1937.
