#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 8 of the Customs Amendment Act 1921, section 3 (5) of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade Act 1948, and section 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1965.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2. The Customs Tariff is hereby modified by revoking item 894.410.1, and substituting the new item 894.410.1 set out in the Schedule hereto.

3. This order shall be in force in the Cook Islands.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order gives effect to a modification of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade by reducing the Most Favoured Nation Tariff on fish hooks from  $17\frac{1}{2}$  per cent to 10 per cent. The order applies in the Cook Islands.
